

# TEEN NIGHT EXHIBITION STUDENT ART SUBMISSION FORM

**CONCEPTICON: Teen Night 2010 (Celebrating MOCA's Conception, Creating its Iconic Future)** is the eighth annual event at The Museum of Contemporary Art (MOCA) exclusively for teens (ages 15–19). This year's event will be held at MOCA Grand Avenue on Saturday, March 13, 2010, from 7–10pm. A student art exhibition by the MOCA Apprentices is a key feature of the event, and you are invited to submit an artwork to be considered for display. All artworks will be displayed on the night of the event **ONLY**.

Inspired by the exhibition *Collection: MOCA's First Thirty Years*, on view at MOCA Grand Avenue, **CONCEPTICON** pays tribute to the museum's origins by highlighting its conception as a contemporary museum and its status as an icon in the art world for the past 30 years. In addition, it proposes the idea that it's up to today's youth to decide where to take MOCA in the future.

This year's student art exhibition has been inspired by On Kawara's *I GOT UP AT...* (1974–1975). *I GOT UP AT...* is part of a larger work produced by the artist between 1968 and 1979 in which he sent friends and colleagues picture postcards stamped on the back with the exact time he arose on that day and the addresses of both sender and recipient. The correspondence ranged from a single card to hundreds sent intermittently over a period of months. The set of postcards that constitutes *I GOT UP AT...*, sent to artist John Baldesarri over the course of three months, stands as a meditation on time, existence, and the relationship between art and life.

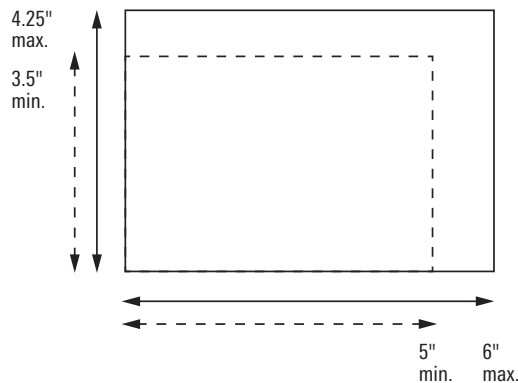
## PRIZE

2. Artwork must be two-dimensional
3. Size is limited to a postcard (See image and chart for dimension or visit [usps.com](http://usps.com))
4. In addition to your postcard artwork and this entry form, please enclose a prepaid return shipping envelope with your return address label
5. No submissions will be accepted after the entry **deadline of March 1, 2010**.
6. All entries must be sent by **standard mail ONLY**.
