Each year, the MOCA Apprenticeship Program (MAP) creates a supportive artistic community for a small, diverse group of high school students. During a nine-month learning and work internship program. Apprentices meet regularly with museum staff and guest artists, undertake individual projects throughout the museum, and discover more about contemporary art, MOCA and their own professional future.

WE ARE CURRENTLY LOOKING FOR APPLICANTS WHO:

Will be in high school during the 2010–11 school year. This is a program exclusively for Juniors and Seniors.

Are self-motivated and have a sincere interest in learning about the arts.

Work well independently as well as with others.

Can commit to meeting at MOCA in Downtown L.A. every Thursday, from 4:30–6:30pm, with occasional weekend activities during the entire internship.

Can be responsible about the position. Participation in meetings and other scheduled projects and events is required. This is a paid museum staff position at \$8 per hour. When the program begins in mid-September, participants will be required to show their legal right to work, including a work permit. Students who may not have such documentation are encouraged and welcome to attend Sunday Studio, free artist-led artmaking workshops held at the museum on the first Sunday of every month from 1–3:30pm.
