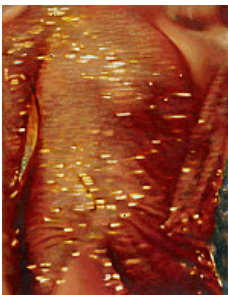

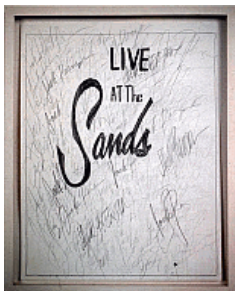
*Jealous Again*, 1991

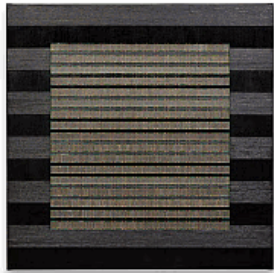

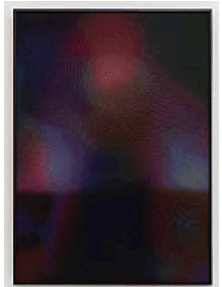
